- **PSO2** The students learn the basics of grammar in an organized manner and also learn to use grammatical structure correctly.
- **PSO3** The students are trained in various creative writing skills like precis writing, paragraph writing, expansion of an idea, report writing, letter writing, and unseen passage. The students are able to think rationally, organize, and convey their idea in a systematic manner.
- **PSO4** Short prose pieces (fiction and nonfiction) poetry and other pieces which deal with Indian culture, science in ancient India to present day, and different aspects of development are taught to students. The student through these texts gains knowledge of these aspects in the English language.
- **PSO5** As English is a global language, the course by developing bilingual skills of the students help in the positive development of their personality and prepares them for competition in global scenarios.

Course Outcome English Language - Undergraduate Ist Year

- **CO1** The students are made aware of basic language skills Grammar and its usage.
- **CO2** The students learn to make informal communication in English like introducing themselves, speaking on simple topics through which they learn the correct pronunciation of words.
- **CO3** Creative writing skills are developed among students through the unseen passage, letter writing, and paragraph writing. Paragraph writing enables students to understand develop and conclude systematically a given idea in one paragraph.
- **CO4** Through short prose pieces and poetry, students are made aware of their rich cultural past, freedom movement, Indian constitution, fundamental rights, individual freedom, and environmental awareness.
- **CO5** The prescribed textbooks develop a feeling of pride for our rich culture, fosters human values, and help students in becoming responsible and dutiful citizens.

Course Outcome English Language Undergraduate IInd Year

- CO1 The textbook contains chapters that focus on different aspects of science, ancient Indian scientists, and modern technology. This enables students to learn about their ancient heritage which was rich in science too. They are also made aware of communication in the modern age, water pollution, how to fight disease and trauma of war.
- CO2 Creative writing focus on unseen passage, report writing, and expansion of an idea. Report writing enables students to visualize an event and report it in a systematic manner. Expansion of an idea helps students to grasp the meaning behind the idea, analyze it and then convey its meaning accurately.
- **CO3** The grammatical and vocabulary exercises further strengthen student's use of appropriate vocabulary and grammatical structure accurately.

Course Outcome English Language Undergraduate IIIrd Year

- CO1 The students are now are expected to write essay type answers of the questions asked from the prescribed textbook. This helps students to prepare lengthy answers with focus on accurate sentence structure, use of correct grammar, and proper development of idea to give the answer to the question asked.
- CO2 The students are trained in creative skills of Essay writing and Precis writing. While in essay writing they have to systematically develop a unified idea with proper introduction and conclusion, in precis writing they have to focus on extraction of key idea from the given passage, give suitable title, justify it and convey the meaning in concise manner. Both these forms of creative writing develop simultaneously in students the quality of expansion and compression in English writing.
- **CO3** It is now expected that the students have a good knowledge of basic grammar exercises, so now they are trained to solve advanced grammar exercises, thereby checking and strengthening their hold on English grammar.

Programme Specific Outcome English Literature

- **PSO1** Ensures intellectual development of students by introducing students to different literary genres, literary devices, and literary terms used in Literature. It acquaints students with different literary periods of English literature.

Course Specific Outcome English literature BA part I

- **CO2** They are also acquainted with the important historical and literary topics of Literature.
- CO3 The poetry focuses on the works of great writers like Shakespeare, Milton, John Donne, John Dryden, Pope, Blake, Wordsworth, Coleridge, Shelley, Keats, Tennyson, and Browning. The students learn to write reference to context and critically analyze the works of these writers.
- CO4 The prose paper focuses on major writers from Bacon to Hazlitt. The students learn about Bacon's impersonal capsules of wisdom, Addison's middle style to lamb's autobiographical and personal style of writing essays. They become well acquainted with their style of writing.
- CO5 The drama takes them into the world of Shakespeare's great comedy, 'The Merchant of Venice' where they learn about human nature and get many useful words of wisdom.
- **CO6** Fiction focuses on the works of Swift, Jane Austen, and Charles Dickens. The student learns the intricacies of writing fiction.

Department of Geography

Programme Outcome

The Bachelors of Arts in Geography is an Undergraduate degree that provides students with the knowledge of physical and cultural features of the Earth and the basic disciplines of Geography and its sub-branches.

The main aim of this programme is to provide students with the knowledge which reflects:-

- 1. Understanding of the whole Earth's surface as a human habitation.
- 2. Understanding of the different terminologies used in geography like Geological time scale, plate tectonics, weather, climate, atmosphere, hydrosphere, etc.
- 3. Understanding of various causes and effects of global warming, acid rain, ozone layer depletion, soil degradation, deforestation, etc.
- 4. The ability to carry out surveying and mapping techniques, use statistical and cartographical methods to solve geographical problems.
- 5. The ability to collect primary and secondary data in the field and analyze data using various statistical formulas.

Programme Specific Outcome

- 1. The programme will help students to practically solve the societal problems by the application of the knowledge gained in the field of Geography.
- 2. Gain basic practical knowledge like Surveying, Data Interpreting, Cartography, Map Making, etc to help them get various jobs in Government as well as Private sectors.
- 3. Inculcate students with the advance contemporary skills like Remote Sensing and GIS.
- 4. Provide students with the understanding of geographical, socio-economic and political background of India.
- Develop sensitization and awareness among the students about the disasters and hazards, know their causes and use the knowledge gained for the management of such calamities.

Course Outcome

- 1. Understand the physical properties of the Earth's surface.
- 2. Get basic knowledge of Earth's Geography like hydrosphere, lithosphere and atmosphere.
- 3. Understand the concept of Earth movements causing earthquakes and volcanoes. Also gain Knowledge of Rocks, Weathering, etc and Evaluation of Landscapes.
- 4. Gain knowledge about the elements is weather and climate, composition and structure of the atmosphere.
- 5. Knowledge about oceans, distribution of temperature and salinity of oceans and seas, current and tides, ocean deposits and coral reefs and oceanic resources.

Human Geography

- 1. Understand the basic concept, definition and scope of human geography.
- 2. Understand the relationship between man and environment, Human Development Index (HDI), etc.
- 3. Knowledge of growth, density and distribution of world population and factors influencing spatial distribution.
- 4. In-depth knowledge about different types of settlements: Urban and Rural Settlements.
- 5. Understand the issues like global warming, climate change, deforestation and different types of pollution.

Economic and Resource Geography

- 1. Understand the various factors of economic development and dynamic aspects of economic geography.
- 2. Classification of economic activities and differentiate between developed, undeveloped and developing countries.
- 3. Classification of industries, transportation, communications and trade.
- 4. Gain knowledge of various natural resources and their uses and conservation.

Geography of India

- 1. Knowledge of physical features of India like structure, Relief, Climate, Physiographic Regions, climate origin and mechanism of monsoon, etc.
- 2. Describe different natural resources, their types, distribution and characteristics in India.
- 3. Understand cultural features of India like Population, agriculture, etc.
- 4. Detailed study of the different regions of India like Kashmir Valley, North-East Region, Chhota Nagpur Plateau, Thar Desert, Islands if India, etc.
